

The European Conference on Information Systems (ECIS) is an annual conference for Information Systems and Information Technology academics and professionals and is affiliated with the Association for Information Systems.

The **Association for Information Systems (AIS)** is an international professional organization serving as the premier global organization for academics specializing in Information Systems. Its mission is to progress knowledge in the use of IT to improve organizational performance and individual quality of work life. AIS has members from over 90 countries, and is comprised of three different regions: Region 1, the Americas; Region 2, Europe, the Middle East, and Africa; and Region 3, Asia and the Pacific. AIS faculty directory currently contains online information about approximately 6,000 IS academics from six different continents.
